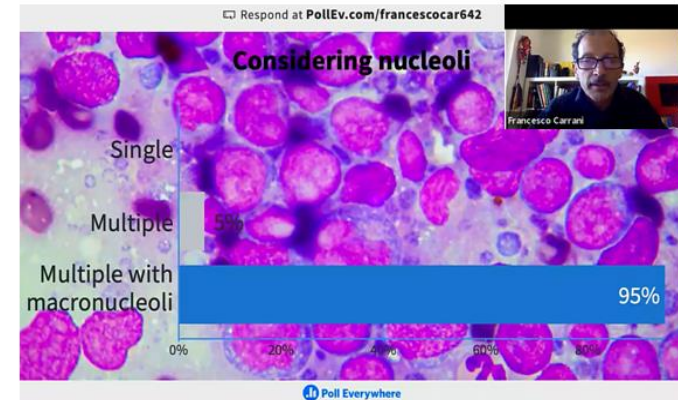

Graduated in Veterinary Medicine at Pisa University in 1992 and post-graduated at the Specialization School of Small Animal Clinic at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine in Pisa, he has attended many national and international courses and workshops on veterinary cytology, imaging diagnostic and oncology. Since 2003 he has lectured courses on cytology in Italy and abroad and has been speaker at International congresses. He is author of the chapter "Cytology of skeletal muscle" in the book "Cytology of dogs and cats". Since 2018 secretary of the Italian Society of Veterinary Cytology (SICIV), member of the European Society of Veterinary Clinical Pathology, SCIVAC and other veterinarian specialistic societies for Cytology and Oncology. From 1998 to 2015 he worked as Chief of the Clinica Veterinaria Cascina 24 ore (Pisa) where he is still now the main referent for cytology, clinical pathology, internal medicine and imaging diagnostic. He works as a consultant for cytology for the private Veterinary Laboratory "La Vallonea" (Rho-MI).
